Item 1: Student Drop Off and Pickup: Please continue to drop off and pick up students at the back of the school in the circular drive. This keeps traffic flowing and keeps the students safe as they wait for their ride.

Item 2: Demographic Information: Families provided updated telephone numbers, email addresses and emergency contact information during Business Days in August and since school began. While these changes may not yet be reflected on Family Access, we do have the copies of those changes in the office and we are referring to the updated information. We ask for your patience as it may take a few more weeks for us to "catch up" and get these changes entered in the system.

Item 3: WASL Results: WASL test results from the Spring 2009 testing are now available in Family Access for students who tested in grades 3 to 12. Families without internet access may request paper copies from school. If you have forgotten your *password*, simply log in to Family Access and click on the link that resends your password to your email.

Item 4: 2009-2010 Walkabout training is scheduled for September 14 at 6:30 PM with guest speaker Ken Wong. Parents are invited to join the training to qualify as additional adult supervision support before the start of school, lunches and at the bus lanes in the afternoons.
